No Surprises, Good Faith Estimate

Under the law, health care providers need to give patients/clients who don't have insurance or who are not using insurance an estimate of the bill for services and related items.

- You have the right to receive a good faith estimate regarding weekly or biweekly counseling, intake costs, case management costs to include; legal court hearings, legal preparation, meetings with attorneys via phone, email, depositions and travel time to/from court proceedings/therapist or expert witness testimony. Disability via long, short and FMLA documentation and submission. Contact with medical health team, mental health team, approved family members, teachers, and other people the client has released information to be disclosed to on their behalf to secure services and or accommodations.
- Clinician will give you a good faith estimate in writing one day prior to services rendered. If you receive a bill that is at least \$400 or more than the good faith estimate, you can dispute the bill.
- Client is to save a copy of their good faith estimate.

1 year, 52 sessions- weekly = \$7,800
Intake = \$200.00
Individual Session = \$150.00
(Not all will require an intake)

1 year, 26 sessions- biweekly = \$3,900

Case Management Rates:

0-5 Minutes = Free
5-25 Minutes \$75.00
25-50 Minutes = \$150.00

Most services require one hour or less to complete. Legal Estimates/FMLA/STD/LTD are based on the above schematic. The cost will reflect the total number of hours and minutes required to complete the requested services.
